The United States Magistrate Judge made findings, conclusions, and a recommendation in this case. A Motion for Reconsideration Under Rule 59E With Objection to Magistrate Recommendation was filed by Plaintiff (*pro se*) on January 29, 2018 (Doc. No. 22). The District Court reviewed *de novo* those portions of the proposed findings, conclusions, and recommendation to which objection was made, and reviewed the remaining proposed findings, conclusions, and recommendation for plain error.
