
ORDER

Before the Court are the Findings, Conclusions, and Recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge therein advising the Court that this civil action should be dismissed with prejudice as frivolous. Furthermore, Plaintiff is **BARRED** from filing future actions *in forma pauperis* in this or any other federal court, without first obtaining leave of court to do so, and any case filed, removed, or transferred without the applicable filing fee, in which he is a plaintiff, should not be reviewed by the Court.
