ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

Before the Court is the petition for writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 of petitioner Kevin D. Rutledge, along with the January 8, 2009, findings, conclusions, and recommendation of the United States magistrate judge.
