ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

Before the Court is the consolidated petition for writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 of petitioner James Lee Smith Jr., along with the October 27, 2008, findings, conclusions, and recommendation of the United States magistrate judge. The magistrate judge gave the parties until November 17, 2008, to file written objections to the findings, conclusions, and recommendation.
