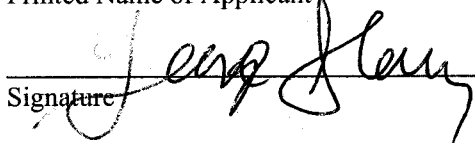

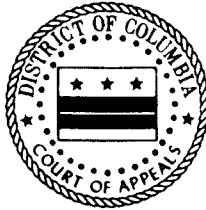

## CERTIFICATE OF STANDING

### TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to certify that according to the records of the State Bar, GEORGE STEPHEN CARY, #073858 was admitted to the practice of law in this state by the Supreme Court of California on December 22, 1976; that from the date of admission to June 16, 1977, he was an ACTIVE member of the State Bar of California; that on June 16, 1977, he transferred at his request to the INACTIVE status as of January 1, 1977; that from that date to July 6, 1981, he was an INACTIVE member of the State Bar of California; that on July 6, 1981, he was suspended from the practice of law in California by order of the Supreme Court for nonpayment of State Bar membership fees; that said suspension remained in effect to March 13, 1984 upon which last mentioned date he was reinstated to the INACTIVE status by the Supreme Court upon payment of all delinquent State Bar fees and penalties; that from that date to January 31, 1985, he was an INACTIVE member of the State Bar of California; that on January 31, 1985, he transferred at his request to the ACTIVE status; that from that date to May 21, 2001, he was an ACTIVE member of the State Bar of California; that on May 21, 2001, he transferred at his request to the INACTIVE status as of May 9, 2001; that from that date to July 1, 2006, he was an INACTIVE member of the State Bar of California; that on July 1, 2006, he transferred at his request to the ACTIVE status; that he has been since that date, and is at date hereof, an ACTIVE member of the State Bar of California; and that no recommendation for discipline for professional or other misconduct has ever been made by the Board of Governors or a Disciplinary Board to the Supreme Court of the State of California.
