

ORDER

This Court has received an Order Referring Motions to Magistrate Judge (doc. 242) signed by the District Judge on February 27, 2012. The Order refers the following: (1) a Motion for an Order Permitting Defendant Orbitz Worldwide, LLC (“Orbitz”) to Share Certain Documents with In-House Counsel Pursuant to the Protective Order (doc. 224) filed by Orbitz, and (2) a Motion to Compel Discovery and for Sanctions (doc. 229) filed by Defendants Travelport Limited and Travelport, LP. (the “Travelport Defendants”).
