

SCHEDULING ORDER

- 1. Trial: Estimated time to try: 3-4 days. Bench Jury
- 2. New parties must be joined by: **8/31/2017**
- 3. Deadline to amend pleadings: **9/15/2017**
Plaintiff must furnish a copy of this scheduling order to new parties. Parties must comply with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 15(a) in amending pleadings before this deadline.
- 4. The plaintiff's experts, if any, will be named with a report furnished by: **11/1/2017**
- 5. The defendant's experts, if any, must be named with a report furnished by: **12/1/2017**
- 6. Discovery must be completed by: **2/15/2018**
Counsel may agree to continue discovery beyond the deadline, but there will be no intervention by the court. No continuance will be granted because of information acquired in post-deadline discovery.
- 7. Parties shall mediate case and submit a status report by: **3/5/2018**
- 8. Dispositive Motions will be filed by: **3/19/2018**
- 9. Deadline for filing pretrial motions to comply with Rule 16(b)(3)(A): **5/10/2018**
- 10. Joint Pretrial Order is due: **5/10/2018**
- 11. Final Pretrial Conference is set for 2:00 p.m. in the Corpus Christi Division on: **5/24/2018**
- 12. Jury Selection will be determined at the final pretrial conference. **TBD**
