

**ORDER**

The Court has received the Magistrate Judge’s August 3, 2017, Memorandum and Recommendation (“M&R”), Dkt. No. 19.<sup>1</sup> The time to file objections has passed, and no objections have been filed. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b) (setting 14-day deadline to file objections); *see also* M&R, Dkt. No. 19 at 4 (advising parties of the 14-day deadline).

After independently reviewing the record and applicable law, the Court **ADOPTS** the M&R, Dkt. No. 19, **DISMISSES** Petitioner’s above-captioned habeas application, and **DENIES** Petitioner a certificate of appealability. The Court further **STRIKES** the duplicate M&R, Dkt. No. 18. Final judgment will be entered separately.
