The Court has received the magistrate judge's Memorandum and Recommendation ("M&R"), Dkt. No. 18, in which the magistrate judge recommends that this case be dismissed for failure to state a claim and/or as frivolous. The deadline to file objections to the M&R has passed, and no objections have been filed. *See* FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b) (setting 14-day deadline to object); M&R, Dkt.
