ORDER

The petitioner, Clarence Martin (TDCJ #01640933), seeks a federal writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 to challenge a state court conviction. Because it appears that his petition is barred by the governing one-year statute of limitations found in 28 U.S.C. § 2244(d), the Court ordered Martin to show cause why this case should not be dismissed as time-barred (Dkt. 7).
