2. The parties must serve all pleadings and motions filed in this action, including supporting memoranda, on the United States, as provided for in 31 U.S.C. §3730(c)(3). The United States may order any deposition transcripts and is entitled to intervene in this action, for good cause, at any time.
3. All court orders will be sent to the United States.
4. If the relators or the defendants propose that this action be dismissed, settled, or otherwise discontinued, the court will solicit the written consent of the United States before ruling or granting its approval
