ORDER

Pending before the court is the Magistrate Judge’s Memorandum and Recommendation (“M&R”), recommending that plaintiff’s motion for attorney’s fees (Dkt. 14) be GRANTED. Dkt. 17. The M&R advises that any parties wishing to object to the M&R must do so by December 27, 2016. *Id.* at 4. The court has received no objections.
