## ORDER ADOPTING MEMORANDUM AND RECOMMENDATION AND ORDER DISMISSING WITHOUT PREJUDICE

This court has reviewed the Memorandum and Recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge signed on February 15, 2019, and the objections filed by the plaintiff, Michel Thomas, and made a *de novo* determination.
