Opinion on Dismissal

- In 2017, Eric Palacio and Almas Khan applied to the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services to make Almas Khan a permanent resident of the United States. Palacio and Khan said that Khan was entitled to citizenship because they were married.
- 2. On January 10, 2020, Palacio and Khan sued the government to compel its decision on Khan's immigration application.
- On January 16, 2020, Palacio requested to withdraw the application; he claimed that (1) their marriage was part of a scheme to help Khan get a green card, (2) they never lived together or had sex, and (3) she was married to someone else.
- 4. Because Palacio has withdrawn the application, this action to compel the government is moot. This case will be dismissed with prejudice.
