ORDER

On September 24, 2018, United States Magistrate Judge Song Quiroga issued a Report and Recommendation in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) recommending that Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. No. 35) be **GRANTED** and that this action be **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**. (Dkt. No. 47). Plaintiff has since filed objections to the Report and Recommendation, arguing that the case should not be dismissed. (Dkt. Nos. 49, 50).
