This firm represents Lobel's of New York, LLC ("Lobel's"), a defendant in the above-referenced action. Enclosed is my application to the Court for admission *pro hac vice* so that I may appear in this case on Lobel's behalf.

Also enclosed is a copy of our Attorney Registration Form for District Electronic Filing, which I have forwarded to the Clerk in the Houston Division. As our registration has not yet been processed, we are presently unable to file, serve or receive documents electronically.

Also enclosed is a proposed motion to dismiss the complaint pursuant to FRCP Rule 12(b), together with (a) a proposed Order granting such relief, and (b) two copies of Lobel's corporate disclosure statement in accordance with FRCP Rule 7.1.
