
ORDER

On September 14, 2010, this Court issued an Order requiring Plaintiff, Deliverance Poker, LLC, to provide Defendant, Michael Mizrachi, and Defendant, Titlware, LLC, with notice of the October 14, 2010, preliminary-injunction hearing. (Clerk's Dkt. #11). The Court Order required the notice to consist of a copy of its Original Complaint (Clerk's Dkt. # 1), Motion for Injunctive Relief (Clerk's Dkt. #2), Amended Memorandum in Support of Motion for Injunctive Relief (Clerk's Dkt. # 8), and the Order requiring Plaintiff to provide notice of the preliminary-injunction hearing. (Clerk's Dkt. #11). The Order further required that "Plaintiff provide Defendants with notice of the preliminary-injunction hearing on or before September 24, 2010." Finally, the Order indicated that "the preliminary-injunction hearing will not take place on **Thursday, October 14th at 2:00 p.m.** if Plaintiff fails to provide Defendants with notice of the preliminary-injunction hearing in the manner required by this Order." As a result of the several requirements set out as a predicate to the preliminary-injunction hearing, the Court now orders Plaintiff to file copies of the notice given to both Defendants. If the notice is not in compliance with the Court's September 14, 2010 Order, the Court, in its discretion, may reschedule the preliminary-injunction hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiff provide the Court with a copy, on or before October 8, 2010, of the notice of the preliminary-injunction hearing that it provided to both Defendants.
