



are filed, the Court reviews the recommendation for clear error or findings contrary to law. *United States v. Wilson*, 864 F.2d 1219, 1221 (5th Cir.) *cert. denied*, 492 U.S. 918 (1989). The Magistrate Judge's recommendation was mailed by certified mail on December 21, 2015. Docket no. 26. No objections have been filed in this case and the time for doing so has expired. Therefore, the Court reviews the recommendation for clear error.

The Court has reviewed the Report and Recommendation and finds that it is neither clearly erroneous nor contrary to law. *Wilson*, 864 F.2d at 1221. Accordingly, the Court ACCEPTS the Magistrate Judge's recommendation and ORDERS that Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment (docket no. 13) be DENIED; that his claims for false arrest, false imprisonment, unreasonable search and seizure, and denial of due process be DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE; and that his claim for use of excessive force be DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE. The Clerk is instructed to enter judgment and close the case.

It is so ORDERED.
