

This case was assigned to United States District Court Judge Clark Waddoups, who then referred it to United States Magistrate David Nuffer under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). On March 16, 2009, the Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation, recommending that Logan River Academy, LLC's Motion to Dismiss be granted.
