

On April 13, 2017, the Court ordered Plaintiff to within thirty days show cause why this case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. The Court noted that it had not heard directly from Plaintiff since he filed a change of address, dated September 29, 2016. Since the order to show cause, the Court has not heard from Plaintiff.
