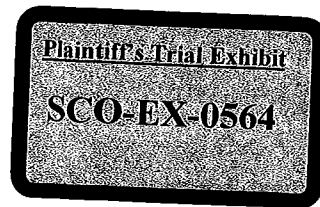

On Friday Joanie Bingham (801-932-5812), assistant to SCO CEO Darl McBride, left phone messages for Patrick McBride and for myself. Darl McBride tasked her with obtaining copies of the contracts whereby Novell acquired UNIX System Laboratories. I returned the call, asked why she wanted the documents -- she believes the purpose is for "IP tracking," to help SCO understand its IP rights.
