Plaintiff Lester Jon Ruston has filed several motions that are currently pending before the court including three motions for leave to file an amended complaint,<sup>1</sup> a motion for service of process,<sup>2</sup> a motion for appointment of counsel,<sup>3</sup> a motion for joinder of additional parties,<sup>4</sup> and a petition for a writ of mandamus.<sup>5</sup> The court previously found that Ruston must prepay the entire filing fee in this case before he is allowed to proceed.<sup>6</sup> The court therefore denies Ruston's motions.
