This case is assigned to United States District Court Judge Dale A. Kimball, who then referred it to United States Magistrate Judge David Nuffer under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). On February 6, 2009, Magistrate Judge Nuffer issued a Report and Recommendation, recommending that Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment be granted.
