ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND
RECOMMENDATION

Case No. 2:09 CV 7 TC

The court referred this case to Magistrate Judge Brooke C. Wells pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). On March 3, 2009, Judge Wells, in a very thorough Report and Recommendation, recommended that this case be DISMISSED under 28 U.S.C. 1915 and that Plaintiff's motions for service of process be DENIED.

The parties were given ten days to file objections to the Report and Recommendation and were cautioned that failure to file an objection could constitute waiver thereof upon subsequent review. Plaintiff filed an objection on March 11, 2009¹. Plaintiff's objection does nothing to cure the infirmities of the complaint.
