Defendant Bloosky Interactive, LLC filed Defendant and Third-Party Plaintiff Bloosky Interactive's Third-Party Claim (Docket No. 60) against Pacific Webworks, Inc. on July 19, 2010, who in turn filed a Motion to Dismiss Bloosky's Third-Party Complaint (Docket No. 73) on September 1, 2010, seeking to dismiss the third-party complaint or in the alternative, to transfer to designated courts agreed to in the contract between such parties, namely federal district courts in Nevada and California.

All parties, with the exception of this third-party complaint, resolved the issues in the pending substantive case.


