On January 26, 2011, Blaine Benard and Roger Myers, attorneys for Google Inc. (“Google”); Blaine Kimrey and Blair Jackson for Bloosky Interactive, LLC (“Bloosky”); and Robert Mansfield, attorney for Pacific WebWorks, Inc. (“PWW”), appeared before the Court for a Status Report and Scheduling Conference.

The parties advised the Court of the status of the case. Namely, Google reports that it has reached a settlement in principle with Bloosky (subject to finalizing certain secondary but material terms) and certain Doe Defendants.

In addition, the parties proposed and agreed to a timeline for several events going forward.


Being so advised and having considered the issues raised at the hearing and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Google is to file a Second Amended Complaint naming additional Doe Defendants by February 23, 2011.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Google, Bloosky, and other settling Defendants are to file a Proposed Stipulated Judgment and Permanent Injunction by February 23, 2011. The Court will take the Proposed Stipulated Judgment and Permanent Injunction under advisement and decide whether to enter the Proposed Stipulated Judgment and Permanent Injunction without a hearing or set the matter for hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court reserves judgment on Pacific WebWorks' Motion to Dismiss Bloosky's Third-Party Complaint until after February 23, 2011.
