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Tom – thanks for the note and kind words.

Your data has not been taken by SpotCrime.com, as they have temporarily stopped pulling data from us. You can verify this by visiting their website (Windsor is not even listed). Perhaps more importantly, to our knowledge, SpotCrime has never focused on scraping data from smaller agencies at all, so I think the possibility of you being directly affected by this is very remote, even if we hadn't filed the lawsuit.

Having said that, we aren't taken any chances. When you join and go live, we make a commitment to present data to the public in a way that the agency can manage and control. Obviously, if someone scrapes the data from us, it would limit our ability to fulfill our end of the bargain. We are eager to get the court to issue an injunction to resolve this issue.

I really appreciate your candid questions and openness. My intent with this email is to be a straight shooter with you about what's happening as well, and we'll keep you up to date along the way.
