Pursuant to the terms of Rule 65, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, plaintiff Public Engines, Inc. ("Public Engines") hereby moves the Court for a preliminary injunction enjoining Defendant ReportSee, Inc., and its officers, directors, employees, agents, and affiliates (collectively "ReportSee") as follows:

(a) enjoining ReportSee from accessing or making any commercial use of the De-Identified Data generated from Public Engines' Publisher software;

(b) enjoining ReportSee from making any commercial use whatsoever of any information from Public Engines' CrimeReports.com website including, without limitation, crime report data that appears on the website;

(c) directing ReportSee to delete permanently from its collection of websites and services to third parties, including SpotCrime.com, all data previously misappropriated from Public Engines;

(d) directing ReportSee to contact all third parties to whom it has provided information misappropriated from Public Engines and directing them to delete misappropriate information permanently from their databases; and

(e) enjoining ReportSee from contacting or communicating with any of Public Engines' customers to misrepresent these agencies' obligations under open records laws or to interfere with Public Engines contractual relationships with those customers.

In further support of this motion, Public Engines respectfully submits its memorandum of points and authorities and the declarations of Greg Whisenant and Steve Meyers, all of which are filed and served herewith.
