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## Xi3 Corporation Rocks CES 2011

*Tens of thousands of prospective domestic and international customers, retailers, distributors and partners crowded the Xi3 Corp. booth at the 2011 International CES tradeshow in Las Vegas to learn more about and place orders for the Xi3 Modular Computer, the Xi3 Z3RO client, the Xi3 Storage SLID3 and Hybrid SLID3 hard-drives, and other Xi3 products*

2011 International CES

SALT LAKE CITY--([BUSINESS WIRE](#))--A last-minute booth expansion notwithstanding, Xi3® Corporation was nearly overwhelmed by the interest it generated at its booth at the four-day 2011 International CES trade show which ended on Sunday, January 9.

Originally slated for a 10X10-foot booth in the South Hall of the Las Vegas Convention Center, Xi3 Corp. made the decision in late November to expand its CES 2011 presence 10-fold to a 1,000-square-foot booth. And according to Xi3 founder and CEO, Jason A. Sullivan, it felt like nearly all of the 130,000 show attendees made it to the Xi3 booth.

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“I figured we would attract a fair amount of interest at CES, but we were blown away by the number of people we attracted to our booth,” Sullivan explained. “Clearly, the concept of Modular Computing has struck a nerve with people, with tens of thousands of prospective customers and partners clamoring for Xi3 info at the show, ranging from large governmental agencies and corporations to small businesses and from retailers and distributors to OEMs and manufacturers.”

Xi3 Corporation chose CES 2011 as the public launch point for its initial products built around the *Xi3 Computer Architecture*, a computer design which breaks up the classic motherboard into three smaller attached boards that can be easily replaced, modified and updated. The result was the creation of the **Xi3 Modular Computer™**, a fully functional computer running a dual-core, 2.0GHz x86 processor housed in an aluminum case that measures less than four inches per side. Also featured at the Xi3 booth with this mid-point Xi3 Modular Computer (5 Series model) were

- the **Xi3 Z3RO™** client,
- the company's external storage solutions – the **Storage SLID3™** and **Hybrid SLID3™** hard-drives, and
- the **Xi3 Mounting Brackets**.

“We've also seen a ton of really positive media coverage already from CES, ranging from major national and international outlets and from blogs to vertical market media properties,” said Aaron Rowsell, COO of Xi3. “And it wasn't just because we had brightly colored five-foot replicas of the Xi3 Modular Computer spinning above our booth. The interest was in seeing a completely new approach to computing – the Xi3 Modular Computer.”

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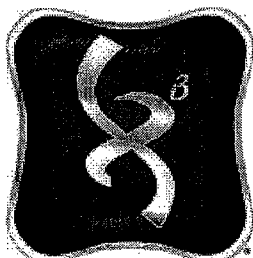
