Before the court is Magistrate Judge Furse's Report and Recommendation (R & R)¹ under [28 U.S.C. § 636\(b\)\(1\)\(B\)](#) recommending that the court grant Defendant's Motion to Dismiss.² Plaintiff Thomas B. Ginter filed a document³ which the court has construed as an objection to the R & R. Ginter's objection fails to directly address any of findings contained in the R & R. Instead Ginter provides a somewhat incoherent list of terms without stating how they relate to his objection or to the R & R.⁴


