**MEMORANDUM DECISION AND
ORDER QUASHING SUBPOENAS**

Defendant Neldon Johnson caused subpoenas (the “Subpoenas”) to be issued on April 24, 2019, commanding District Judge David Nuffer and Magistrate Judge Evelyn J. Furse to appear at a hearing in this case on April 26, 2019.¹ Johnson served the Subpoenas by U.S. mail, addressed to the federal courthouse in Salt Lake City, where they were received on April 29, 2019.² Among other deficiencies, the Subpoenas were not timely or properly served.³

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Subpoenas¹ are QUASHED.
