**ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND

Before the Court is the Report and Recommendation issued by United States Magistrate Judge Brooke Wells on July 12, 2017, recommending that Plaintiff's Complaint be dismissed with prejudice because the Court lacks subject matter jurisdiction over this matter. Plaintiff was notified of his right to file objections to the Report and Recommendation within fourteen (14) days after receiving it. On July 21, 2014, he requested an extension of time until August 23, 2017 to file his objections. The Court granted the extension.
