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The undersigned referred this case to Magistrate Judge Brooke C. Wells pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B),<sup>1</sup> and the case was reassigned to Magistrate Judge Cecilia M. Romero on June 11, 2019.<sup>2</sup> On August 27, 2019, Judge Romero issued a Report and Recommendation.<sup>3</sup> Judge Romero recommends the Commissioner of Social Security's decision denying Plaintiff's claim for disability insurance benefits under Title II of the Social Security Act be affirmed.<sup>4</sup> Neither party objects to Judge Romero's Report and Recommendation, so the court reviews the Report and Recommendation for clear error.<sup>5</sup>

Having carefully considered Judge Romero's Report and Recommendation, the court finds no clear error. The court therefore ADOPTS Judge Romero's Report and


