

We have requested a reasonable and narrow portion of the source code in view of testimony from the deposition of Mr. Alferness and other information produced by Google in this litigation. We reserve our right to request additional production of source code, as necessary, as discovery proceeds. Please confirm by June 28 that Google agrees to produce this source code, and please confirm that it will be available by no later than July 5. If Google will not produce the source code, we request a meet and confer on July 2, so that we may either resolve this issue – during that call – or move the Court to compel the source code.
