**MOTION TO SEAL PLAINTIFF I/P ENGINE, INC.’S OPPOSITION TO
DEFENDANTS’ MOTION IN LIMINE #4 TO PRECLUDE PLAINTIFF FROM
OFFERING EVIDENCE OR ARGUMENT RELATING TO DEFENDANTS’ CONDUCT
DURING DISCOVERY OR TO GOOGLE’S UNPRODUCED LICENSES ALONG WITH
EXHIBITS 1 AND 2**

Pursuant to Local Rule 5 and the Agreed Protective Order entered by the Court [Dkt. No. 85], Plaintiff I/P Engine, Inc.
