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**MOTION AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO EXPEDITE  
BRIEFING FOR I/P ENGINE’S MOTION FOR REVIEW OF JUDGE LEONARD’S  
RULING ON I/P ENGINE’S THIRD MOTION FOR DISCOVERY SANCTIONS  
REGARDING UNTIMELY DISCOVERY RESPONSES**

Plaintiff I/P Engine, Inc. (“I/P Engine”) moves the Court to expedite briefing on Plaintiff’s Motion for Review of Judge Leonard’s Ruling on I/P Engine’s Third Motion for Discovery Sanctions.
