# <u>DECLARATION OF BRIAN KUETHE IN SUPPORT OF DEFENDANTS' OPPOSITION</u> TO PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR AN AWARD OF POST-JUDGMENT ROYALTIES

- I, Brian Kuethe, declare as follows:
- 1. I am a senior financial analyst at Google Inc. I provide this declaration upon personal knowledge and, if called upon as a witness, would testify competently as to the matters recited herein.
- 2. Google does not publicly release its quarterly revenue figures until two to three weeks after the end of each quarter. During the weeks immediately following the close of a calendar quarter, Google is compiling and ratifying financial results from the quarter. Google releases its quarterly earnings report in an official announcement after such data is complete.
- 3. In order to make any payment, Google's finance department must receive an invoice or other acceptable documentation detailing the precise payment amount. It generally takes

Google's finance department up to 30 days to process a payment after receiving an invoice due

to the size of the department and the number of requests for payment the department receives

each month.

4. Google's finance department does not process payments for 4 business days at the end of

each month.

5. It is not feasible for Google to prepare a statement certifying under penalty of perjury the

U.S. revenue attributable to Google's use of AdWords in dollars and the calculation of the

royalty amount "no later than 14 days after the end of each calendar quarter." Google does not

finalize its quarterly earnings figures until two to three weeks after the end of each quarter and

does not publicly release this information until finalization. Google cannot make an accounting

to a third party before the quarterly revenue figures are publicly released because Google is a

public company bound by the rules of the Securities and Exchange Commission

6. It is not feasible for Google to make a royalty payment "no later than 14 days after the

end of each calendar quarter." Google does not collect and finalize the underlying revenue

figures until two to three weeks after the end of each quarter, and after that revenue information

is finalized, Google must process any request for payment through the finance department.

7. Google could make a royalty payment and provide an accounting of the quarterly U.S.

revenue attributable to Google's use of AdWords within 60 days after the end of a calendar

quarter.
