

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Plaintiff, a Virginia inmate, brings this 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. In his amended complaint, Plaintiff named Cathy Hill, C.T. Woody, and Cheryl Robinson as defendants. By Memorandum Opinion and Order entered on March 17, 2010, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's claims against Defendants Hill and Woody. On April 30, 2010, Defendant Robinson filed a motion for summary judgment. By Memorandum Opinion and Order entered on October 19, 2010, the Court granted Plaintiff's second motion to amend and filed Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint wherein Plaintiff added Undersheriff Pruitt as a defendant. Thereafter, on November 29, 2010, Defendants Robinson and Pruitt filed a motion for summary judgment with respect to the Second Amended Complaint.

In light of the foregoing circumstances, Defendant Robinson's motion for summary judgment filed on April 30, 2010 will be DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE to consideration of the motion for summary judgment filed on November 29, 2010. Plaintiff's "REPLY TO
