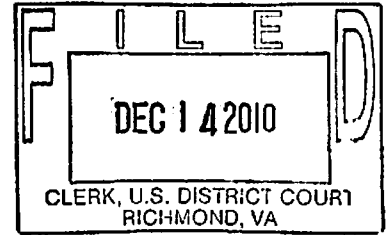

ORDER

By Order dated September 10, 2010 (and filed on September 13, 2010) (Docket No. 18), the pending DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DISMISS THE COMPLAINT PURSUANT TO FED. R. CIV. P. 12(b)(1) AND 12(b)(6) was referred to Magistrate Judge M. Hannah Lauck for report and recommendation. Having reviewed the REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION of the Magistrate Judge entered herein on December 10, 2010 (Docket No. 26), and having considered the record and the REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION and finding no error therein, it is hereby ORDERED that the REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION of the Magistrate Judge (Docket No. 26) is ADOPTED on the basis of the reasoning of the REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION.

It is further ORDERED that the DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DISMISS THE COMPLAINT PURSUANT TO FED. R. CIV. P. 12(b)(1) AND 12(b)(6) (Docket No. 18) is denied without prejudice and the parties will be

permitted to file supplemental briefing. A separate Order shall issue establishing the supplemental briefing schedule.

The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Order to the plaintiff and to Magistrate Judge Lauck.
