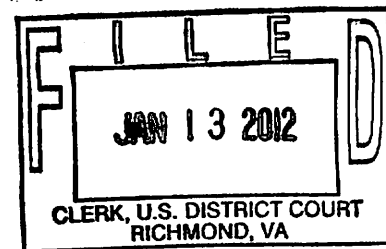

I appeared in the court room earlier today on the above matter.

Respectfully, I thank the court for acknowledging my late filed "Amicus Letter".


