MEMORANDUM OPINION

By Memorandum Order entered on February 10, 2012, the Court conditionally docketed Plaintiff's civil action. Plaintiff's failure to contact the Court and provide a current address indicates his lack of interest in prosecuting this action. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). Accordingly, the action will be DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
