

## MEMORANDUM OPINION

Mrit of Habeas Corpus & Maladministration Proceeding Under 28 U.S.C.A § 2241. Power

To Grant Writ" ("Habeas Petition") (Docket No. 1, at 18 (internal quotation mark omitted).)
