## AMENDED MEMORANDUM OPINION

Azael Dythian Perales submitted a document which he styled "Petition For Appeal,
Writ of Habeas Corpus & Maladministration Proceeding Under 28 U.S.C.A § 2241. Power
To Grant Writ" ("Habeas Petition") (Docket No. 1, at 18 (internal quotation mark omitted).)
By Memorandum Order entered on February 14, 2012, the Court directed Petitioner to show
cause why the action should not be dismissed for failure to comply with Federal Rule of Civil
Procedure 8(a)(1). On March 14, 2012, United States Postal Service returned the February 14,
2012 Memorandum Order to the Court marked, "REFUSED" and "RETURN TO SENDER
Undeliverable." Since that date, Perales has not contacted the Court to provide a current address.
Plaintiff's failure to contact the Court and provide a current address indicates his lack of interest in prosecuting this action. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). Accordingly, the action will be
DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
