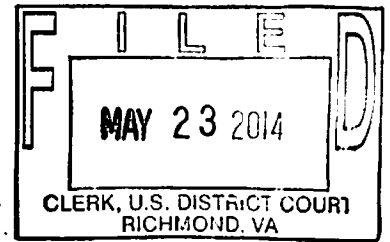

MEMORANDUM OPINION

By Memorandum Order entered on April 9, 2014, the Court filed Salome Brown-El's petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On April 18, 2014, the United States Postal Service returned a April 9, 2014 Memorandum Order to the Court marked, "RETURN TO SENDER," "NO MAIL RECEPTACLE," and "UNABLE TO FORWARD."
