

## MEMORANDUM OPINION

By Memorandum Order entered on May 21, 2014, the Court conditionally docketed the action. Sheron O'Dell By Memorandum requested leave to proceed in forma pauperis. Order entered on July 2, 2014, the Court directed Gentry to pay an initial partial filing fee of \$8.66 or state under penalty of perjury that he did not have sufficient assets to pay such a fee within eleven (11) days of the date of entry thereof. U.S.C. § 1915(b)(1). Gentry has neither paid the initial partial filing fee nor averred that he cannot pay such a fee. Therefore, Gentry is not entitled to proceed in forma pauperis. Gentry's disregard of the Court's directives warrants dismissal Accordingly, the action will be dismissed of the action. without prejudice.
