MEMORANDUM OPINION

Metaphyzic El-ectromagnetic Supreme-El, a Virginia inmate proceeding <u>pro</u> <u>se</u>, submitted a petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. By Memorandum Order entered on May 21, 2014, the Court directed Supreme-El to complete and return, within fifteen (15) days of the date of entry thereof, an affidavit in support of his request to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> or pay the \$5.00 filing fee. The Court warned that failure to comply with the above directive would result in dismissal of the action. More than fifteen (15) days have passed and Supreme-El has not returned the required <u>in forma</u> pauperis affidavit.

Supreme-El has failed to pay the assessed fee or adequately explain any special circumstances warranting excuse from payment. Accordingly, the petition will be dismissed without prejudice. The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Memorandum Opinion to Supreme-El.
