MEMORANDUM OPINION

By Memorandum Order entered on December 8, 2014, the Court conditionally docketed this action. The December 8, 2014 Memorandum Order warned Eric D. Johnson that the Court would dismiss the action if he failed to keep the Court informed of his current address. On May 14, 2015, the United States Postal Service returned a May 4, 2015 Memorandum Order to the Court marked, "RETURN TO SENDER" and "UNABLE TO FORWARD." Johnson's failure to contact the Court and provide a current address indicates his lack of interest in prosecuting this action. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).
