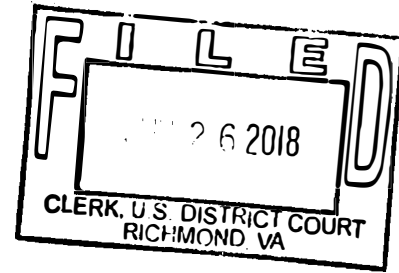

**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

By Memorandum Order entered on June 12, 2018, the Court conditionally filed Plaintiff's complaint.
