Before me is the Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment. Both parties have briefed the issues and the Court held a motion hearing on May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2011. For the reasons explained in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, the Court **GRANTS** the Plaintiff's Motions for an Extension of Time, but **HOLDS** Plaintiff's counsel in **CIVIL CONTEMPT** for his two violations of the Scheduling Order and **IMPOSES A FINE** of **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS** upon Plaintiff's counsel. The Court further **GRANTS** the Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment on the Title VII claim and **DECLINES** to exercise supplemental jurisdiction over the Plaintiff's Virginia Human Rights Act claim. The Clerk of the Court is directed to **DISMISS** this case from the docket.
