## **ORDER**

This matter was referred to the Honorable Robert S. Ballou, United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B), for proposed findings of fact and a recommended disposition as to plaintiff Barbara Hudson's second motion for attorneys' fees and expenses (Dkt.
